Progress Report from Task Force on Water-land Interface and Harbourfront Activation

REPORTING PERIOD

This progress report covers the period from mid-June 2021 to mid-January 2022, where one Task Force meeting and one site visit were conducted.

MEETING HELD AND THE MAJOR OUTCOME, FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Twenty-third Meeting – 7 December 2021

2. The Task Force discussed the following item –

Harbourfront of the People, by the People, for the People – a Community Making Approach at HarbourChill by Social Ventures Hong Kong

- The HarbourChill, a themed harbourfront space located next to the Pierside Precinct of Wan Chai Ferry Pier, is a harbourfront experiential space co-created by community professionals from all walks of life and was fully opened in May 2021. Since its opening, Social Ventures Hong Kong (SvHK), a non-governmental organisation, had organised various events to activate the site which were well-received by the public. In view of the successful experience, SvHK was invited to share their experience in organising activities at the HarbourChill using the community making approach, as well as its future direction.
- Members were supportive of the community making approach, whereby the public and the Government could co-create and activate the waterfront. The experience also empowered different community

stakeholders to explore and bring in diverse activities to the harbourfront.

VISIT

3. The Task Force conducted a site visit-cum-briefing to inspect the installation process of the shoreline units at Tsuen Wan Promenade on 29 December 2021 with the Task Force on Harbourfront Developments in Kowloon, Tsuen Wan and Kwai Tsing.
