



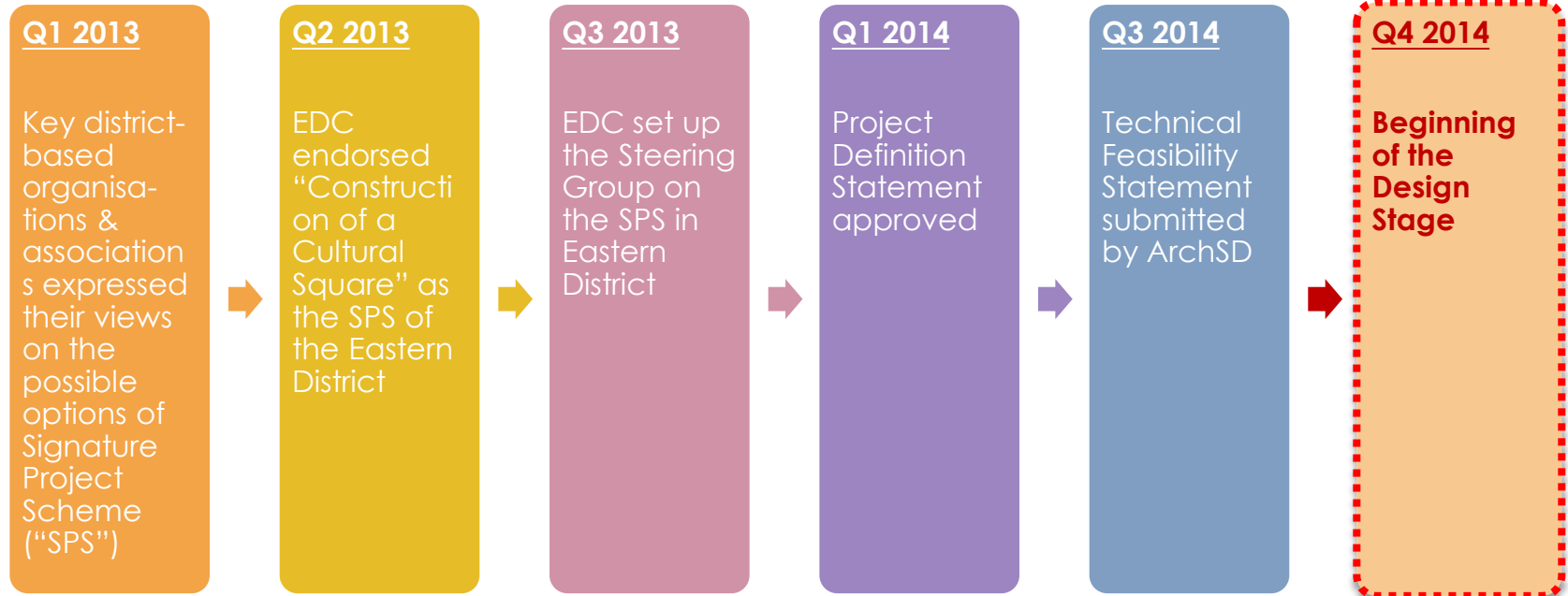

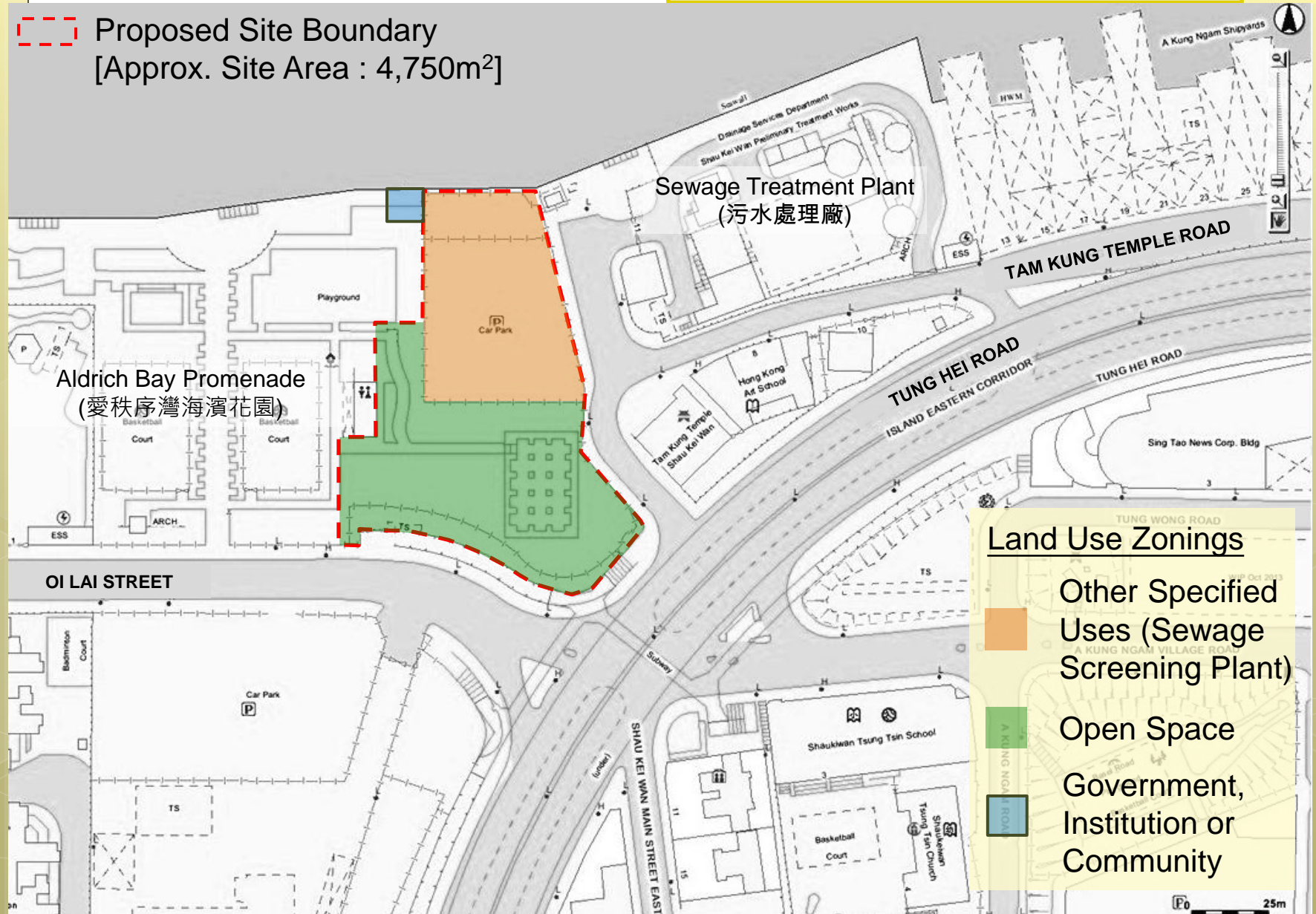

LCSD's Park: Aldrich Bay Promenade (ABP)

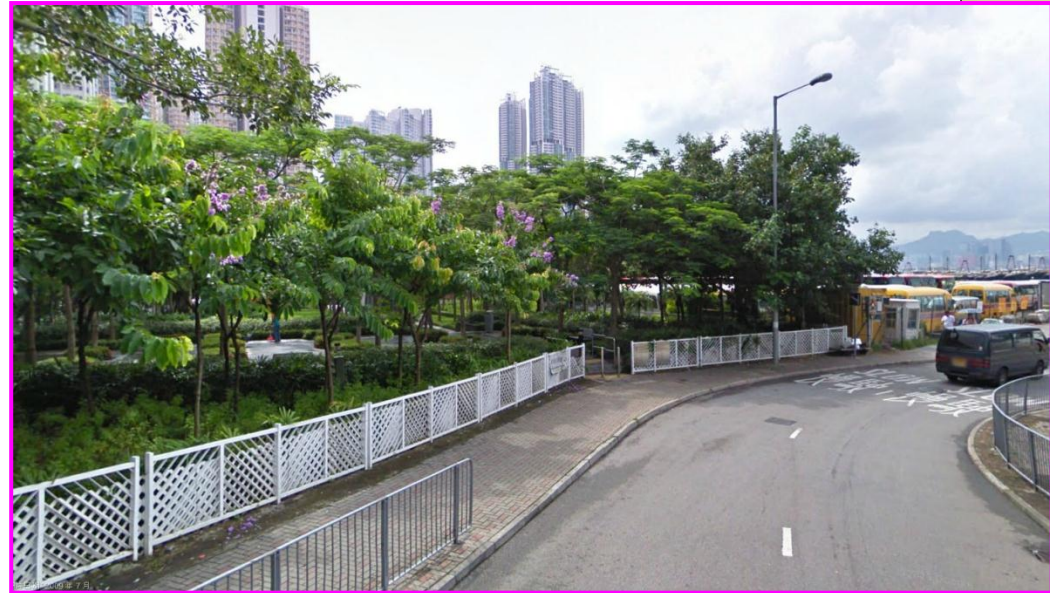
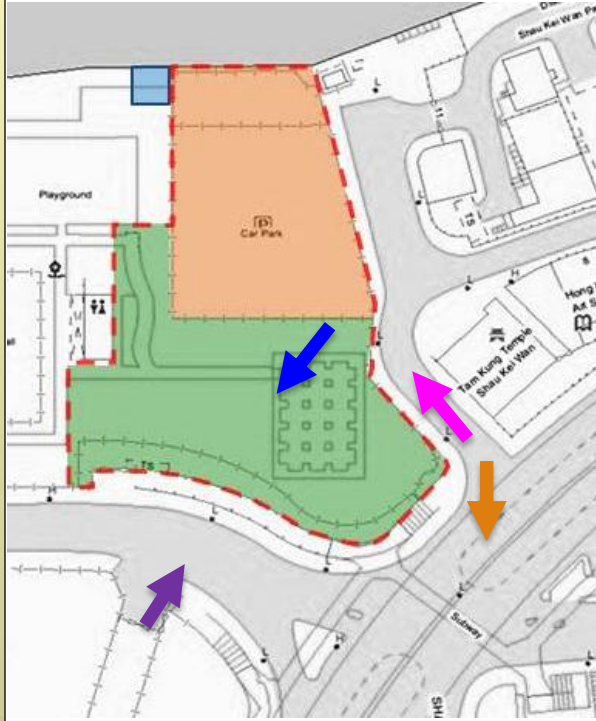
Tam Kung Temple (Grade 3 Historic Building)

Less accessible sitting-out area of ABP due to hidden entrances

Lack of open space for district popular cultural activities such as Festival of Tam Kung, Cantonese Opera, etc.

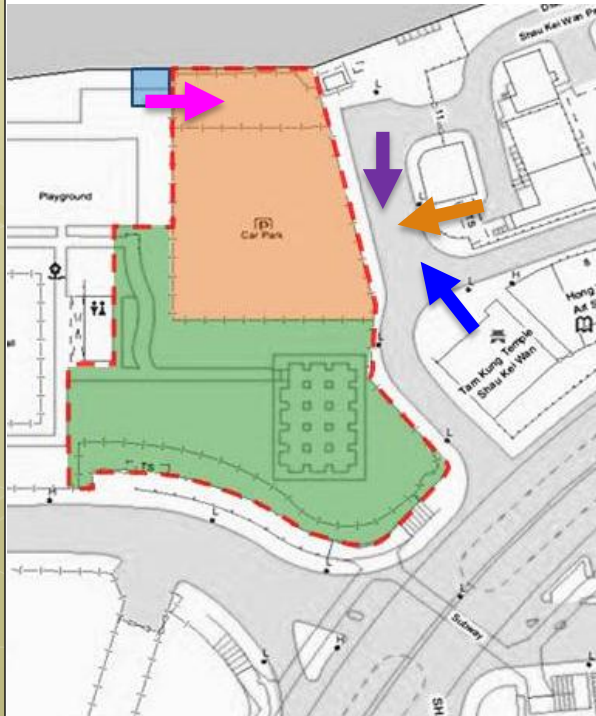

# Objectives (2/3)

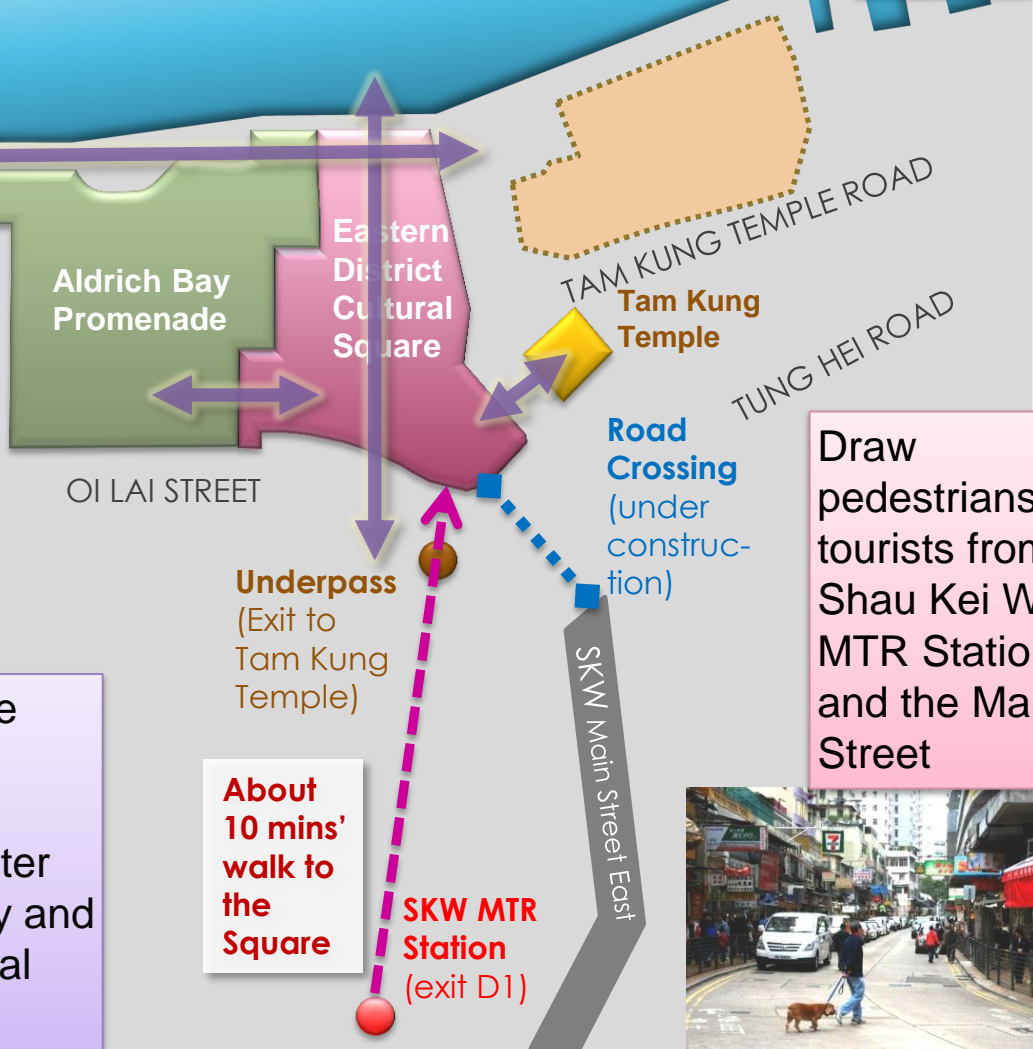
Enhance permeability and connections with the waterfront



To Sai Wan Ho, Aldrich Bay Park and Soho East

- Estimated population of the surrounding constituencies around 52,000 in 2015

- Nearby 7 schools & 10 residential estates such as Aldrich Garden, HOS



Draw pedestrians / tourists from Shau Kei Wan MTR Station and the Main Street

Attract more visitors and daily users through better accessibility and more cultural activities

About 10 mins' walk to the Square

- ◉ A waterfront promenade



- ◉ Sitting-out area



# Scope of Non-works & Partners

- Community involvement: community activities will be organised to facilitate the involvement of the stakeholders of the Eastern District; and
- Publicity: various activities will be organised in collaboration with EDC
