


Enhancement Works of







Location of the Proposed Ancillary Facilities








Display panels





- To display notices at appropriate locations along the promenade
- To provide life buoys along the promenade for emergencies.
- To deploy venue staff to step up the cleansing and maintain the order of the promenade.





 The estimated cost of the project is about \$2 million and the additional recurrent expenditure involved is about \$0.75 million a year.

Implementation Schedule

 Subject to the comments of the Task Force, LCSD will commence the enhancement works in November 2016 and the proposed facilities are expected to be completed and open to the public in March 2017.
