


Major Comments from Key Stakeholders in CE2


- The Harbourfront Commission and the Society for Protection of the Harbour suggested that the space under IEC was not utilized
- EDC and the public generally welcomed the 10m-wide boardwalk proposal put forward in CE2 and urged for early implementation of the project
- The provision of a cycle track, viewing platforms, activity nodes and fishing platform was supported.
- There should be demarcation between walkway and cycle track to enhance safety for all users
- More access points should be provided




Stage 3 Community Engagement (CE3) (Min. 10m wide underneath IEC)







Latest Scheme – Eastern Portion



The Latest Scheme

- To maximise utilisation of the space underneath the existing footprint of the IEC for implementing the Boardwalk.
- The total length of the minimum 10m width Boardwalk is about 1.7 km and 1.3 km among it will be laid at the area underneath the existing Island Eastern Corridor structure.
- The extent of the Boardwalk that would be built outside the footprint of the IEC has been minimized to 400m.
 This could not be put under the IEC due to insufficient headroom underneath.


