





Scope of study

- a. To determine a proper WQ standard for water sports
- b. To conduct WQ monitoring (12 months minimum) and assessment at the Precinct
- c. To investigate options for improving water quality for conducting water sports activities
- d. Public consultation

Way Forward



1. Quick-win Promenade Programme

- Phase I (Q2 2020 Q4 2020)
- Phase II (Q2 2020 Q4 2021)

2. Public Furniture Competition

- To be launched in Q2 2020

3. Trial of Water Sports Activities

- Engage Water Sports Council on potential events in Q3 2020

Long Term

Water Quality Assessment

- Employment of Consultant in 2nd half of 2020
- Water Quality Monitoring in 2021 (Duration of at least one year)

Summary of comments from HC Members on Briefing Session on 11 May 2020

Promenade design

- a. Provide more/larger scale shading
- b. Supplement lighting design
- c. Adopt some common language of two projects
- d. Provisions of electricity and water supply, etc. (to facilitate events and F&B)



- a. Provide land status of interfacing projects
- b. Coordinate interfaces with CWB project (access and beautification of existing site office at the east of Hung Hing Road)
- c. Coordinate with SCL on possible early release of site at Finger Pier
