About 24m wide and 500m long

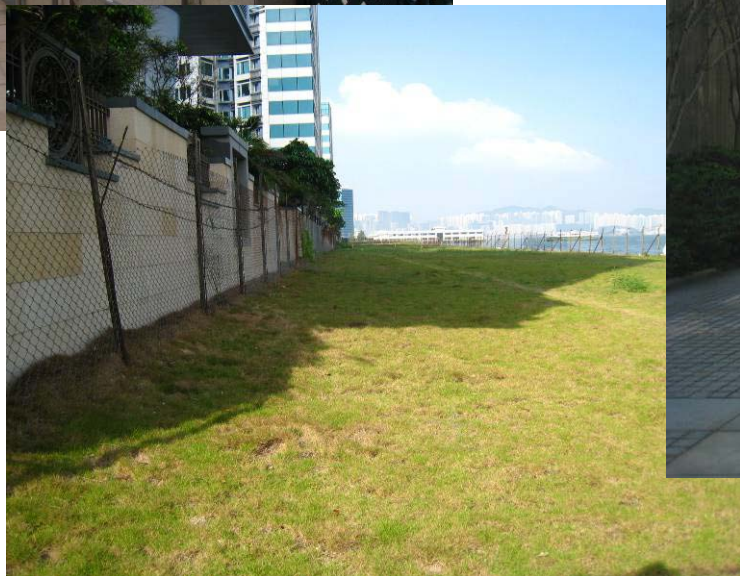


Site Location 地盤位置

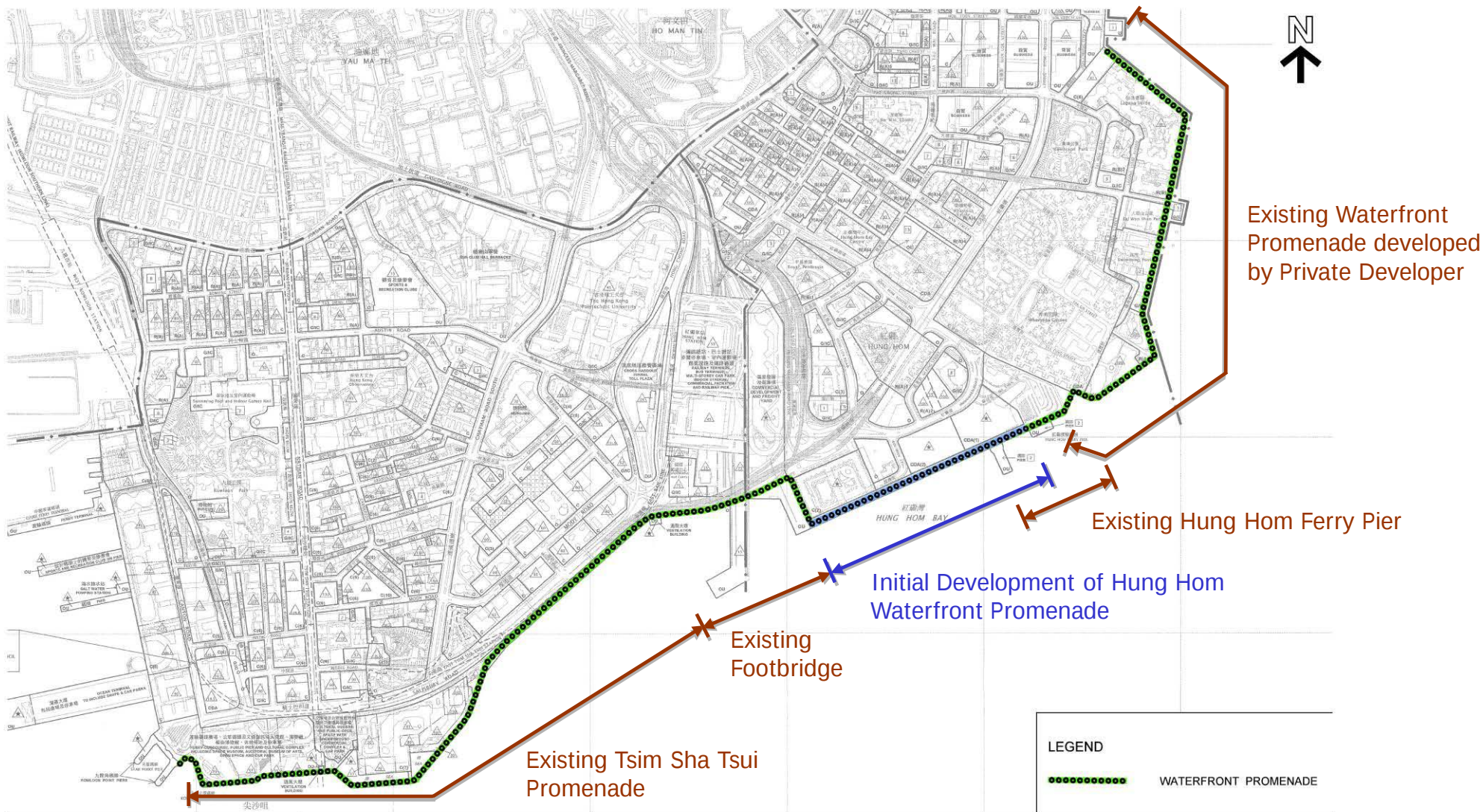


Tsim Sha Tsui end - Pre-construction Condition

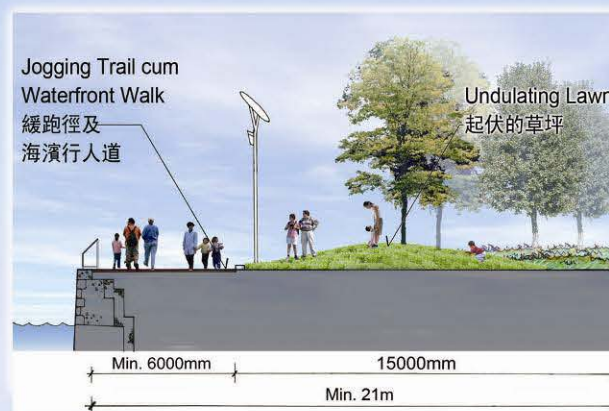

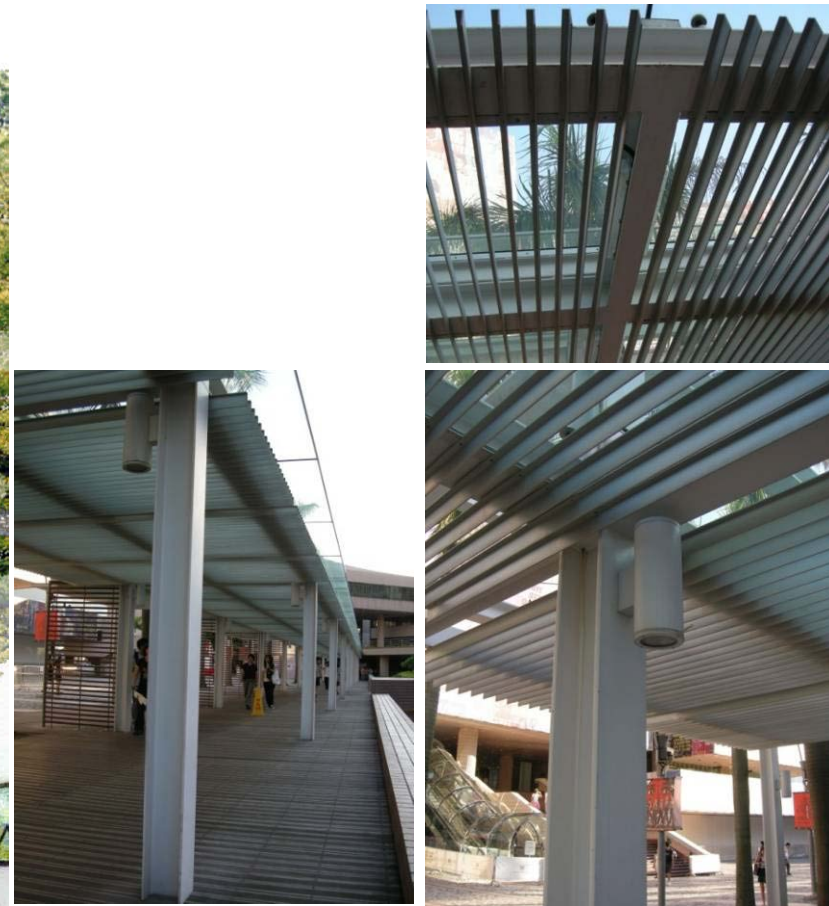
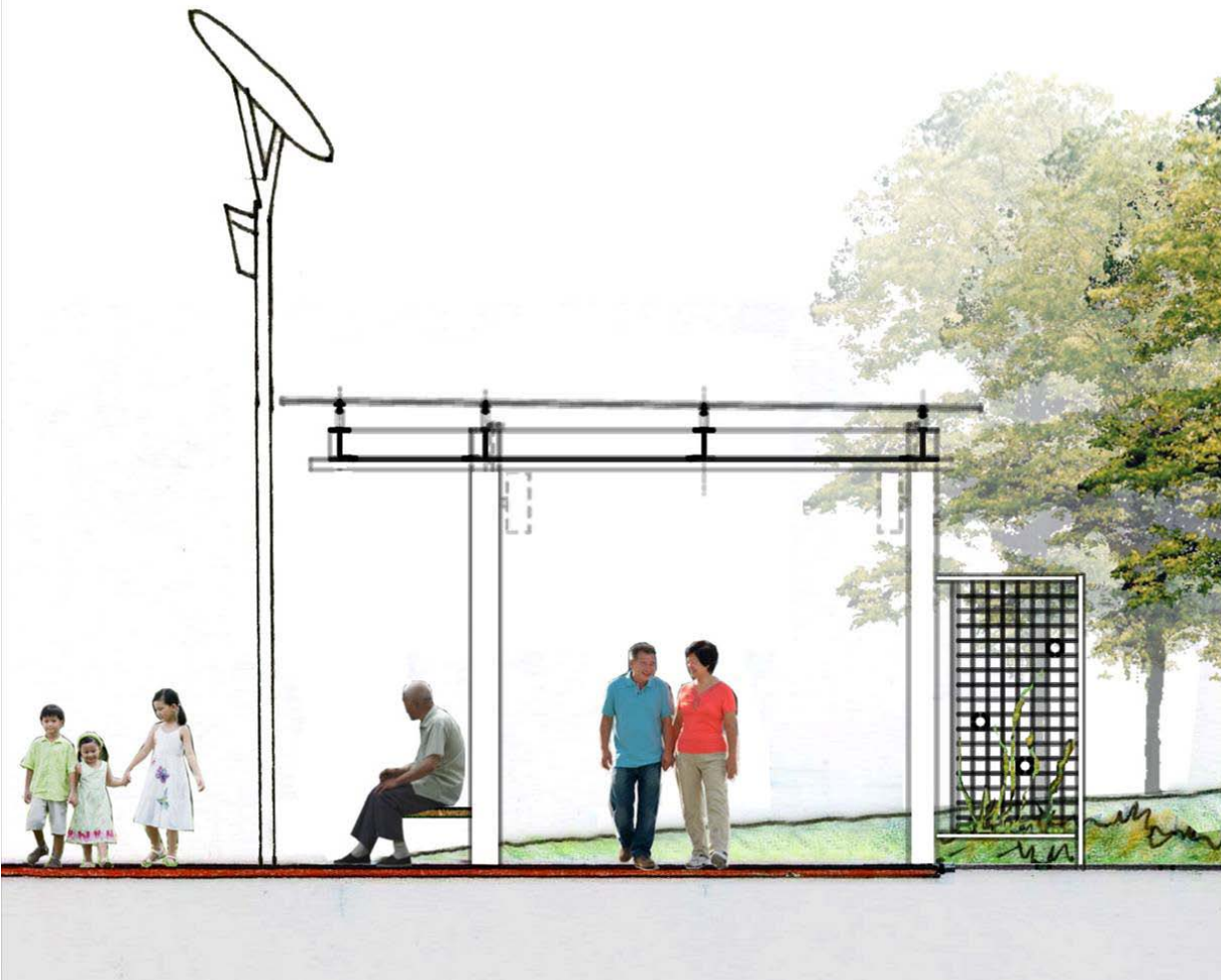

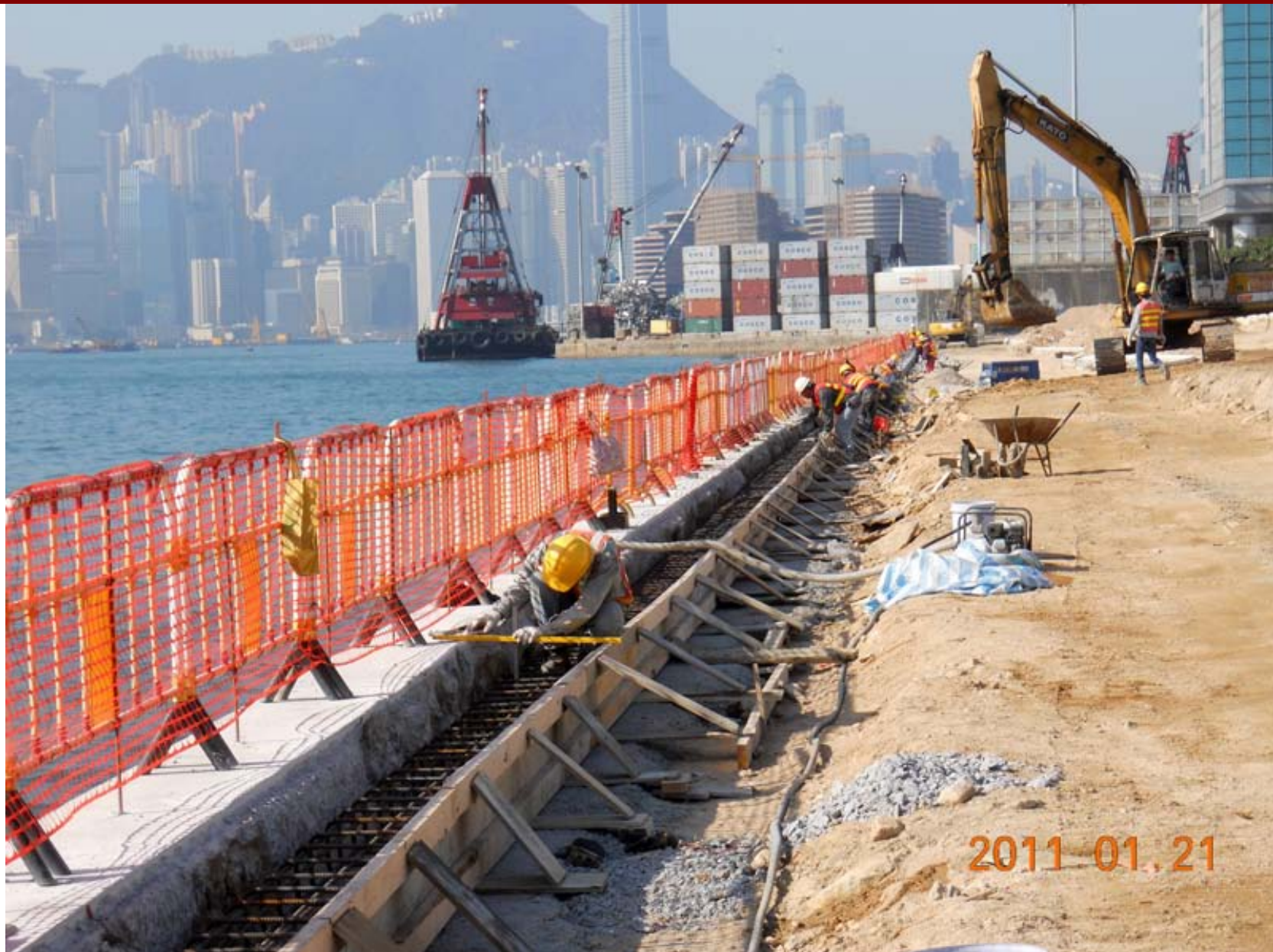

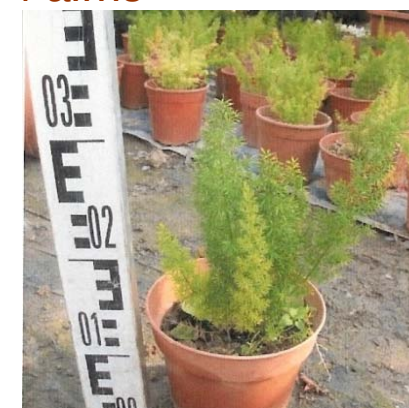
