
**Growth of Registered Pleasure Vessels  
limited by lack of berths**






## Demand for Sheltered Space by Pleasure Vessels




**Demand for sheltered water for pleasure vessels is expected to exceed supply by 2015**

# Building - Operating Boat Clubs




- A boat club is an anchorage or boat rack for leisure craft with land-based facilities for the users.
- A boat club could be built / operated by:
  - Developer (e.g. Gold Coast)
  - Private club (e.g. Aberdeen Marina Club)
  - Government institution (Water sports and rental only, there are no public boat clubs in Hong Kong.)
  - Non-profit organization (e.g. Tai Po Boat Club)
- Main infrastructure (slipways, steps, breakwater) are to be included in public work or private development.
- Land to be dedicated for supporting facilities.
- Hoist, racks and pontoons are subsidized for public use, paid by membership and mooring fees, or PPP.
