





## <u>Planning and Design Study on Redevelopment of Government Sites at</u> <u>Sai Yee Street and Mong Kok East Station (MKES) – Feasibility Study</u>


- Commissioned by PlanD to investigate the redevelopment potential of the government sites at Sai Yee Street currently used by WSD and FEHD along with the adjoining temporary car park on Sai Yee Street (to be known as Sai Yee Street Site) and the adjoining area of MKES.
- Objective: to increase supply of office/commercial floor space and transform the study site into a commercial hub in East Mong Kok.
- Will look into interface issues with existing MKES and provide recommendations to improve pedestrian accessibility.
- Take 12 months to complete and scheduled for commencement in 2014.












### <u>Integrated Planning: Relocation of FEHD Resource Centre</u>





## Addressing Local Concern: Rear Cover of Refuse Collection Vehicles (RCVs)

> RCVs are of an **enclosed** type design and fitted with **rear cover**, preventing the overflow/leakage of refuse/odour.





## Addressing Local Concern: Automatic Deodorising and Cleaning Spray System

- RCVs are installed with automatic deodorising and cleaning spray system.
- During the local refuse collection process, a fixed amount of deodorising and cleaning agent will be sprayed by the system immediately upon the completion of refuse collection and closing of the rear cover to kill the bacteria which generates bad smell.





# Addressing Local Concern: Automatic Vehicle Washing Machine at Refuse Transfer Station (RST)

- ➤ All RCVs are **not** loaded with any refuse when they leave and enter the depot.
- Refuse disposal and vehicle washing at RST.
- ➤ Vehicle washing by automatic vehicle washing machine for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time at the new Depot.



## Adjustment of In-and-Out Schedule of RCVs to Avoid School Peak Hours



## Consultation with the Food and Environmental Hygiene Committee (FEHC) / Yau Tsim Mong District Council on 26 September 2013

- ➤ Reported findings of TIA, EIA, revised vehicular routings and updated in-and-out schedule of RCVs at the meeting.
- The revised vehicular routings are acceptable to FEHC.
- ➤ FEHC suggested another round of local consultation to cover additional stakeholders such as Harbour Green, Metro Harbour View, etc. before FEHC is consulted again.

## **Way Forward**

- Further consultation with FEHC/Yau Tsim Mong District Council after the conclusion of wider local consultation to be conducted in Q1 2014.
- Funding submission to Public Works Subcommittee and Finance Committee/LegCo via Panel on Food Safety and Environmental Hygiene.
- Tentative programme is to commence work in 2015.
- Return of the Sai Yee Street site to Lands Department for commercial development in 2019 after demolishing the building structures at Sai Yee Street and commissioning of the new offices-cum-vehicle depot at Yen Ming Road.
