## **Proposed Approach**

- Knit into the existing framework of various harbourfront enhancement initiatives –
  - By categories (transport, leisure/recreational, industrial, municipal)
  - By timeframe (improvements on short, medium and longterm basis)
  - By geographical areas (22 Action Areas)
- Priority accorded to those enhancing the vibrancy and accessibility of the Harbour for public enjoyment. Focus on key issues that require more urgent attention.

  - Identify and implement "quick-wins"


