



Waterfront Event Sites

- Sites for a variety of public activities on permanent and temporary stages to create <u>unique destination</u> <u>experiences</u>
- Attractive and affordable entertainment that appeals to a wide range of users and increase waterfront use








- Ample distributed power
- Good water pressure
- □Foul water connections
- □IT connectivity

Concluding Thoughts!

- Existing waterfront areas need to be evaluated and suitable event sites identified
- Identify missing audience and technical needs at existing locations that could be upgraded
- An integrated event site masterplan should be developed for waterfront areas
- Plans should be made to fill perceived gaps in existing provision with new event sites
- New event sites would be purpose-designed for required style and scale of events
