Progress Report from Task Force on Kai Tak Harbourfront Development

REPORTING PERIOD

This progress report covers the period from October to December 2011.

MEETING(S) HELD AND THE MAJOR OUTCOME, FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Seventh Meeting – 18 October 2011

2. The Task Force discussed the following item -

(a) Amendments to the Approved Kai Tak Outline Zoning Plan No. S/K22/2

- The Planning Department together with the Civil Engineering and Development Department briefed Members on the amendments to the approved Kai Tak Outline Zoning Plan No. S/K22/2, which was available for public inspection until 26 October 2011. The major amendment items included preservation of the Lung Tsun Stone Bridge remnants, realignment of the underground shopping street, design enhancement of Grid Neighbourhood, the government offices cluster in the city centre and enhancement of accessibility to the waterfront at the South Apron and former runway.

- Various proposed amendments were presented to the Task Force at its previous meetings on 7 September 2010, 23 November 2010, 11 January 2011 and 1 June 2011. The meeting concluded that Members were generally supportive of the amendments.
- In passing, Members also expressed comments on the “Energising Kowloon East” initiative announced at the Chief Executive’s 2011-12 Policy Address. The Meeting noted that the Harbourfront Commission would be briefed on the subject at its 8th Meeting scheduled for 13 December 2011.
